CALL FOR ENTRIES

The North Carolina Museum of Art requests American made automobiles to be considered for inclusion in the juried American Cars and Hot Rods Meetup event to be held at the Museum in conjunction with the fall exhibition *Porsche by Design: Seducing Speed*. The American Cars and Hot Rods Meetup will be held at the Museum's Blue Ridge Road parking lot on Saturday, November 9, 2013. Entries will be juried by Ezra Dyer, *New York Time* "Wheels" and Yahoo! Autos blogger and columnist for *Automobile* magazine. Because of limited space, only a select number of automobiles will be chosen for inclusion in the American Cars and Hot Rods Meetup Winners Circle. No entry fee.

PROCEDURE

Automobile owners must submit digital images, a maximum of four, to the North Carolina Museum of Art Foundation, Inc., at Robert.Mlodzik@ncdcr.gov.

Only .jpg or .tif files will be accepted and are not to exceed 2 MB. Resolution must be at least 72 ppi (at 5 x 7 inches or 7 x 5 inches approximate dimensions). Images must be correctly oriented.

Image Files

Files must be submitted under the owner's name (last name first) and model of vehicle.

EXAMPLE: Doe_John_1968Dodge440ChargerRT.jpg

Should an owner have multiple American automobiles and choose to submit more than one entry, each file must be labeled individually.

TEXT FILES

In addition to image files, owners must submit the following for each entry:

- (A) The signed Display Agreement.
- (B) A Word document that states the following:
 - Owner's first and last names
 - Owner's address (street, city, state, Zip)
 - Telephone number
 - E-mail address
 - Web site (if applicable)
 - Year, make, and model of vehicle
 - Colors of vehicle (exterior and interior)
 - Year the vehicle was acquired
 - Important modifications made to the vehicle
 - Any awards the vehicle has won

(C) Owner's statement of no more than 500 words describing why this vehicle is unique or significant

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: September 20, 2013

Owners of selected automobiles will be notified by October 11, 2013.

REQUIREMENTS OF PARTICIPATION FOR OWNERS OF SELECTED AUTOMOBILES

Automobiles selected for the Museum's American Cars and Hot Rods Meetup Winners Circle must be brought to the North Carolina Museum of Art at the owner's expense. Automobiles must arrive at the street-level Blue Ridge Road parking lot by 7:30 am on Saturday, November 9. The lot will be closed to the public by 7:45 am.

The event is open to the public from 8:30 am to 1 pm. Vehicles must remain in the Winners Circle until the end of the event. The Museum assumes no liability for any damage to vehicles. The vehicle owner or a representative must stay with the vehicle for the duration of the event.

AWARDS

The juror will select one automobile as Best in Show and one automobile as Honorable Mention. The owner of the automobile that is awarded Best in Show will receive a Dual Membership (\$65 value); a \$30 gift card for Iris restaurant; a copy of the *Porsche by Design: Seducing Speed* exhibition catalogue; and the Museum's *Handbook of the Collections*. The owner of the automobile that is selected Honorable Mention will receive a Dual Membership (\$65) and a copy of the *Porsche by Design: Seducing Speed* exhibition catalogue.

Display Agreement

Submission of digital images constitutes an agreement between the vehicle owner and the North Carolina Museum of Art. By submitting digital images to the Museum it is understood that should a vehicle be selected, the specific vehicle represented in the digital images will be brought to the Museum for display in the American Cars and Hot Rods Winners Circle on Saturday, November 9, 2013. No substitutions will be allowed.

Owners will not be compensated for transportation or participation. The owner grants the Museum permission to photograph any selected vehicles for publicity, publications, films, and television programs that are produced or sponsored by the Museum, as well as to use images on the Web in relation to the *Porsche by Design: Seducing Speed* exhibition and the Car Meetup events.

Vehicle owner agrees to display the vehicle for the entirety of the event, 8:30 am–1 pm.
