- The owner of the automobile that is awarded Best in Show will also receive a North Carolina Museum of Art Dual membership (\$65 value); a \$30 gift card for Iris restaurant; a copy of the *Porsche by Design: Seducing Speed* exhibition catalogue; and the Museum's *Handbook of the Collections*.
- The owner of the automobile that is selected Honorable Mention will also receive a North Carolina Museum of Art Dual membership (\$65 value) and a copy of the *Porsche by Design: Seducing Speed* exhibition catalogue.

Entry Rules and Requirements:

- Open to all artists 18 years or older. The committee reserves the right to review and approve or refuse all works presented for consideration.
- The art car is created at the owner's expense.
- Artists/owners are responsible for the legal drivability of their art cars.
- Proper vehicle registration and insurance is the responsibility of the owner and/or participant.
- The event is open to the public from 8:30 am to 1 pm on Saturday, November 30, 2013. Automobiles must arrive at the street-level Blue Ridge Road parking lot by 8 am. Security will close off the parking lot by 8:10 am.
- Cars must remain in the display area until the end of the event (1 pm).
- The Museum assumes no liability for any damage to the car. The vehicle owner or a representative must stay with the vehicle for the duration of the event.
- All art car entries must be in good working condition or can be moved on a trailer using another working vehicle.
- No entries may present a safety hazard.
- All entries must be suitable for family viewing.
- The owner grants the Museum permission to photograph any art cars for publicity, publications, films, and television programs that are produced or sponsored by the Museum, as well as to use images on the Web in relation to the *Porsche by Design: Seducing Speed* exhibition and the car meetup events.
