Visiting the People's Collection in West Building

A Suggested Visual Schedule

1. Let's enter West Building.



2. Feel free to use the Art Smart Activity Cards located on a shelf near the restrooms at the main entrance. Borrow the cards that include hands-on activities related to various works of art throughout the collection. Return the cards to the shelf when finished. Next we will walk through the galleries. We will learn about different kinds of art.



3. Walk to the American Galleries and look at the salon wall. What do you see? What is your favorite artwork? Why?



4. In front of the artwork is a digital label. Engage with the label by clicking on one of the objects to see it up close. Can you spot details that are not visible from afar?



5. We will take a break if we need one. Nearby is a long bench.



6. Now let's head straight across the Rodin Court toward the back wall of the European Galleries. You will find a touch station. Touch the surface of the replicas of two paintings hanging on the walls around you. What do you feel?



7. Now it's time to leave. If you borrowed any Art Smart Cards, please return them to the shelf near the main entrance. We had a great day at the NCMA!
